DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO THE WYNDHAM RALEIGH/DURHAM-RESEARCH TRIANGLE PARK

Driving From Raleigh-Durham International Airport

Exit the airport onto Terminal Boulevard. Turn right onto Airport Boulevard. Turn right onto I-40 West toward Durham/Chapel Hill. Take Exit 281/Miami Boulevard and go right off the exit ramp onto S. Miami Boulevard. The hotel driveway will be the first one on the left.

From I-85 North

Take I-85 North to I-40 East. Take Exit 281/Miami Boulevard and go right off the exit ramp. The hotel driveway will be the first one on the left.

From I-85 South

Take I-85 South to 70 East. Stay on 70 East for approximately 5 miles. At the 4th stoplight, turn right onto Miami Boulevard. Follow Miami Boulevard for 3½ miles. The hotel is on the right immediately after the additional lanes begin.

From 70 East

Take 70 East to Miami Boulevard and turn right. Stay on Miami Boulevard for 3½ miles. The hotel is on the right immediately after the additional lanes begin.

Taxi Service

Use the courtesy phone in the airport baggage claim area to call for taxi service to the hotel (approximately \$20).

DRIVING TO THE EPA CAMPUS, RESEARCH TRIANGLE PARK

Driving Directions From the Wyndham

From the hotel, turn right on S. Miami Boulevard and turn left to take the ramp to I-40 West. Take Exit 279A/Alexander Drive and merge onto NC-147 S. Turn left onto Route 2028/TW Alexander Drive. Go 0.3 miles to the stoplight and turn left into the main entrance of the EPA-RTP Campus. Visitors must stop at the Guard's station to show photo identification and get a parking pass. Continue past the National Computer Center on the left as you come up the driveway and follow the signs to the Main Campus entrance and visitor's lot.

From Raleigh, Raleigh-Durham International Airport, and Points East via I-40

Take I-40 West toward Research Triangle Park, Durham, and Chapel Hill. Take Exit 279A/Alexander Drive and merge to the right. Proceed to the T-intersection at the stoplight and turn left onto Alexander Drive. Go 0.3 miles and turn left at the entrance sign for the EPA Research Triangle Park campus. Visitors must stop at the Guard's Station to show photo identification and get a parking pass. Continue past the National Computer Center on the left as you come up the driveway and follow the signs to the Main Campus entrance and visitor's lot.

From Chapel Hill and Points West via I-40

Take I-40 East toward Raleigh. Take Exit 279A/Alexander Drive. At the stop sign, turn right and proceed to the T-intersection with the stoplight. Turn left at the T-intersection onto TW Alexander Drive. Go 0.3 miles and turn left at the entrance sign for the EPA Research Triangle Park campus. Visitors must stop at the Guard's Station to show photo identification and get a parking pass. Continue past the National Computer Center on the left as you come up the driveway and follow the signs to the Main Campus entrance and visitor's lot.

From Downtown Durham via Durham Freeway

Take the Durham Freeway (NC 147) South toward Research Triangle Park. Where the Durham Freeway ends at the T-intersection, turn left onto Alexander Drive. Go 0.3 miles and turn left at the entrance sign for the EPA Research Triangle Park campus. Visitors must stop at the Guard's Station to show photo identification and get a parking pass. Continue past the National Computer Center on the left as you come up the driveway and follow the signs to the Main Campus entrance and visitor's lot.
